Center and advised she believes she has found the home of the suspect in the SJSO dog dumping case located at 80 Rymshaw Dr. She told dispatch that 40 plus dogs are being starved and the homeowners, Carolyn Loveman or Chris Loveman, will not let Palm Coast Animal Control check on the welfare of the animals. I called Caroline and spoke with her about her findings. Caroline stated she obtained this information from the S.M.A.R.T. posts on Facebook stating there is a \$5,000 reward for any information on this case. She stated she believes family or close friends called in and told her the information. Further, she said the condition of the home became so bad, Chris and Carolyn moved into a shed at the back of the property while all the dogs occupied the home. Caroline advised Carolyn had recently moved out of the shed and to 96 Ryan Dr. with family members.

I next spoke with Officer Heather Priestap with the Palm Coast Animal Control over the phone. She advised she had prior calls at the home but was denied access to the home in 2024. There have been no recent cases at this address. I asked Officer Priestap that if we were to make contact and she is willing to surrender the dogs, if she has them, if she could she facilitate that, and she stated yes. I attempted contact at the home with no answer. However, we did hear multiple dogs barking from inside the home.

On Tuesday, May 18, 2026, at approximately 1315hrs, I responded to 80 Rymshaw Dr, reference to SJSO Detectives who have spoken with Carolyn Loveman and she admitted to having 28 dogs in the home and wants to surrender them. I contacted Officer Heather Priestap who advised she would respond. Upon my arrival, I met with Carolyn, SJSO Detectives, and Palm Coast Animal Control. Carolyn produced 48 small dogs, contrary to the 28 she advised earlier, appearing as Chihuahua, Beagle, Yorkie mixes, 16 of the dogs were puppies from a recent litter. Some of the dogs appeared to have mange with missing patches of fur all over the body, fleas, had long unkept nails, and feces/urine on their feet. During the extraction of the dog, Carolyn came out of the home with blood running down her hand/ She advised that she had been bitten by one of the mother dogs in the home. Palm Coast Fire Rescue was called to the scene to evaluate her. Her hand was wrapped but Carolyn refused further treatment. Officer Priestap took the animals to the East Coast Veterinary Hospital located at 7 Kings Way, Palm Coast FL, under the care of Dr. Michael Tajmir.

After the dogs were removed from the home, I asked Carolyn for consent to check the home for any remaining dogs. She advised no, she does not consent. Later, after reviewing the condition of the dogs and speaking with Dr. Tajmir, I returned to Carolyn and advised I am obtaining a search warrant for the home and explained the process to her. Carolyn told me she now wants to give consent to search. I explained the option to give consent to search for the home was completely optional and voluntary, and she can rescind at any point, which she understood. Carolyn completed a Consent to Search form and I stayed with her while Deputy J. Patel *909 searched the home with CSI.

For further details on the inside condition and what Deputy Patel observed, please see his report. During this time, I read Miranda warnings to Carolyn, and she waived her rights to speak with me. I asked Carolyn how long she has had these dogs, she said two (2) years, and they have never been to a vet. I asked her how this situation got this way and she stated she started with a small amount and they started breeding to the point it got

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out of hand and took over the whole house. She stated she feeds them twice a day and makes sure they have water however, the situation got out of hand and the dogs deserve better because I can't take care of all of them. Carolyn stated she has never taken them to a vet and has been self-treating them for worms. I asked her how many she has had in total and she stated around 50 dogs. Let it be noted, approximately 23 dogs were recovered from the SJSO case, putting the new total number at 71 dogs.

According to Deputy Patel's report, the following was observed:

Deputy Patel entered the residence with members of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office Crime Scene Investigation Unit. The Crime Scene Unit was on scene to document the residence with photographs. Walking into the garage, the odor of urine was emanating from the interior of the residence. Once the interior garage door was opened, the overwhelming odor of urine and feces poured out of the residence. The door jamb where we stood was covered in residue/grime, which appeared to be where animals have come into contact with while having feces/urine on their paws. Once inside, the floors were observed covered in urine and feces leading to the kitchen. There were multiple holes in multiple walls where animals had dug into the wall, wearing the drywall out so much that insulation and studs were visible. On the kitchen counter, an opened can of Vienna Sausages were out and contained multiple roaches in and around it. Roaches were observed crawling all over the center island and the floors of the kitchen. Past the kitchen was what appeared to be an empty dining room, which contained a gate commonly used to keep animals separated from a certain area. There were multiple piles of feces present in such a small area, and it was clear that some of the piles had been there for days on end. Flies were present in the area and after only being in the residence for a few minutes, a break was needed from the burning sensation in my eyes and the urine odor in the air.

As we walked outside, there were multiple bags of trash on the back porch that contained dog feces and had flies swarming them. The backyard was overgrown and there was an above-ground pool that had not been maintained, which contained dark brown water. There was a shed on the property that had not been cleared yet, which was included in the Consent to Search Form. I knocked on the door and heard barking coming from what seemed to be a small dog. I requested Deputy C. Anderson assist me in clearing the shed for safety of any occupants. Upon entering, I discovered there was at least one small dog, possibly a Chihuahua. The animal weighed no more than three pounds, had hip and rib bones showing, and its penis was hanging out. After a few moments, the dog's penis would not return to its normal state. While the Crime Scene Unit began taking photographs of the shed (makeshift apartment with A/C, bed, etc.), I was notified by Deputy Joseph that Carolyn had rescinded consent and wished for all procedures to stop. All photographs were immediately concluded and the shed was closed. It should be noted there were still two small dogs inside, in addition to the one that suffered from the condition stated before. That same dog was removed from the residence, and it was brought to Carolyn's attention that the dog needed some sort of medical attention. Carolyn advised that the dog is approximately a year old and that the condition is not medical in nature and that it has only occurred recently. It was expressed to Carolyn that the condition is not normal for a dog, or any domesticated animal for that matter. Carolyn advised she would be surrendering the three

remaining dogs to Animal Control as well. Deputy C. Anderson advised Carolyn that the search and photographs were concluded for the time being as she rescinded her consent. She was also advised that now, a search warrant would be created and that entry into the home is not permitted. It should be noted that only portions of the residence were searched prior to going outside. The hallway where it appeared the puppies were kept was not searched. Bedrooms and bathrooms were not searched either.

Photographs of some of the animals from the initial visit were taken and uploaded to Evidence.com. In the backyard, there is a shed with an AC unit. In the shed, there were three (3) additional dogs of the same mixed breeds listed above. I was asked to look at the dogs and the condition of the shed. Deputy D. Joseph *1269 stayed with Carolyn while I looked at the shed. One of the dogs, a small Chihuahua, appeared emaciated with its spine, ribs, and shoulder blades showing under the skin. The dog also had what appeared to be paraphimosis, a condition where the genitalia of the dog is unable to return into the body. The dog appeared to have multiple sets of teeth and missing a large amount of hair. Under the bed where they were found, was a large amount of feces and urine where they appeared to be living near a dog bed. At this time, Carolyn invoked her rights and wanted the search to stop. The dog with the medical condition was brought to Carolyn and she spontaneously uttered the dog needed to seek veterinary attention. Carolyn stated the dog has been having that medical issue for some time, stated approximately aware for 1 month, but has not taken him to the vet. Carolyn did, however, request animal control to return to surrender the remaining dogs in the shed.

The total dogs removed from the residence of 80 Rymshaw Dr, on this day is 51. The dog was taken to East Coast Veterinary Hospital for evaluation. I spoke with Dr. Tajmir on the phone and who sent a synopsis of "Pinky" the Chihuahua advising the dog was 1 year old and weighed 1.5lbs. he did have paraphimosis and appeared to have not been taken care of. The dog also still had all his baby teeth with his adult teeth. Its spine had a condition called kyphosis that can be brought on by living in a confined space.

A search warrant was obtained and signed by the Honorable Judge Katherine Miller and executed at 2118hrs and the warrant was read and given to Carolyn.

In the shed, there was a strong smell of feces and urine. There was a bed, TV, dresser, and a loft. The AC was on and it was a cool environment. A dog bowl with water but no food.

In the home, there was a strong smell of feces and urine, to the extent it made my eyes water. Due to the amount of feces covering the floor, it made for unlivable conditions and created a slipping hazard for all occupants moving through the residence. The baseboards and drywall of the home appeared to be eaten by the dogs and made holes in them. Furniture was also chewed on, a similar appearance to cribbing that equine will do. There were varying species of insects throughout the home including cockroaches in different sizes, indicating multiple generations. A can of Vienna Sausages was left out on the kitchen counter, and it appeared to have been there for a significant amount of time due to the extensive amount of insects on it and that have consumed it. Behind bedroom doors, there were multiple layers of what appeared to dog feces piled as if it was only swept into the

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threshold of the door. Large trash bags were found in the home as if it was actively being cleaned. Trash bags contained soiled dog beds, food trash, and large amounts of feces were located in the living room area. A trash bag was taped over the window of the front door and the curtains were shut. The search was concluded and all documentation was collected and submitted.

On 5/20/2026, I received a General Condition Outline from Dr. Tajmir regarding the 51 dogs that came from the 80 Rymshaw Dr. See below as a direct copy of his report.

"To whom it may concern:

Please be advised of the conditions the chihuahuas and other small breed dogs (51 in total) were noted as below. These dogs/puppies were all brought in on Monday, May 18th at approximately 3:30pm to our facility.

- General condition: Most were slightly underweight.
- Skin abnormalities: Most of the dogs (excluding the puppies) had some level of flea allergic dermatitis along their caudal dorsum. This included scabbing and alopecia (hair loss). Live fleas were noted on multiple patients.
- Paws: Majority of the dogs had fecal material matted on their paws along with very long nails, some that were curling over.
- No microchips were noted (all dogs were scanned).
- Fecal PCR testing was performed through our outside laboratory (Antech). This testing was positive for giardia in majority of the cases.
- Tapeworms and another parasite (cryptosporidium) were also diagnosed in a couple of patients.
- All dogs testing negative for heartworm disease
- All eligible dogs (none of the nursing/lactating females) were vaccinated for rabies, distemper, leptovirus, parvovirus, parainfluenza virus, hepatitis and bordetella.
- Every dog is intact.
- Some dogs (Pinky, Merry) had retained deciduous (puppy) teeth which need to be removed.
- Chihuahua #23 had a skin infection secondary to flea infestation that required antibiotic and steroid therapy outside of the routine bath all the patients received.
- Nursing females were not on appropriate diet, as the need for puppy food for nursing females is paramount to preventing substantial calorie deficits and eclampsia.

Based on the above physical and laboratory findings, many of the conditions above could have been avoided with routine basic care. Giardia is a parasite/protozoa that is often found in contaminated water. It is due to poor hygiene, (ie, pets constantly walking in fecal material) and causes gastrointestinal pain, diarrhea, cramping, vomiting, etc. Giardia also has the possibility of being transmitted to people. Tapeworm infestation can be avoided by keeping pets on a flea preventative. When a dog ingests a flea, they develop tapeworms. Tapeworm infestations cause weight loss, intestinal disease and can migrate to other areas of the body causing other damage.

On May 21, 2026, at approximately 1300 hours, I conducted a sworn audio interview with Dr. M. Tajmir in reference to the needs and treatment of the animals. The following is a brief synopsis of the information provided in his interview:

- The chihuahua "Pinky" is diagnosed with Paraphimosis.
- "Pinky" requires a 2-part surgery to rectify this condition.
- 31 other dogs suffered from numerous medical conditions consistent with being kept inside of a confined space/area without proper movement and exposure to natural elements including but not limited to tape worms, dermatitis, fleas, and parasites.
- None of the animals were spayed/neutered and are currently undergoing surgery for this.
- Many of the conditions can cause great bodily harm and/or death if left untreated.
- The conditions of the home included a severe flea infestation.
- For further details on the interview with Dr. M. Tajmir, please see the file uploaded to evidence.com

Please see full vet records attached for details about the individual dogs and their conditions. Per Dr. Tajmir, "Pinky" will now need extensive surgery on his teeth and the paraphimosis to keep the penis in the body due to the length of time it went untreated.

Based on the condition of the home, the condition of the animals, the number of animals owned which became "uncontrollable", Pinky and other dogs having visible medical conditions that were not treated or seen by a vet in a timely manner but known by Carolyn, multiple animals having signs of neglect and being underweight, the following charges are being perused:

828.12(1) - CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

Carolyn did unlawfully and unnecessarily overload, overdrive, torment, deprive of necessary sustenance or shelter, or unnecessarily mutilate, or kill any animal, or cause the same to be done, or carry in or upon any vehicle, or otherwise, any animal in a cruel or inhumane manner, to wit: Carolyn was in control and owned 51 dogs in a single home where the environment of the home became so unlivable, the owner had to move out and leave the dogs, the ground was covered in feces and urine creating a smell strong enough to make eyes water, the spread of giardia often found in not cleaning the water sources, infestation of insects in the home including fleas causing tapeworm, the animals had many medical conditions that could have been avoided with routine basic care, contrary to Florida Statute 828.12(1). (1 DEG MISD)
